Notably, the title "marshal" is utilized in all parishes, excluding East Baton Rouge and Orleans, where officials are referred to as "constables."

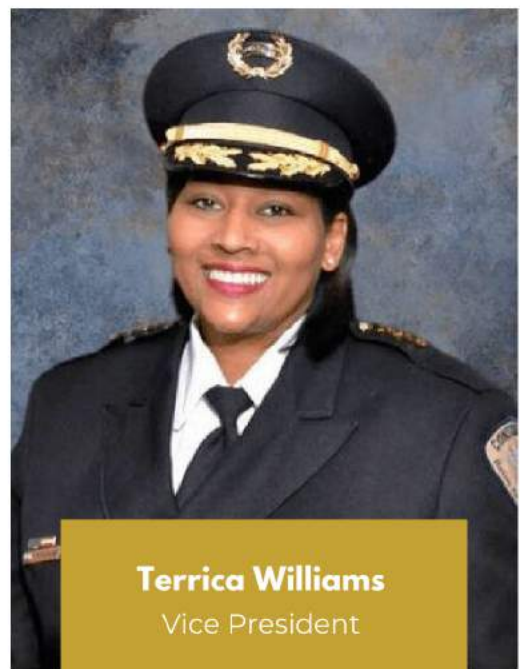

Together, they work towards enhancing unity, cooperation, and professionalism within the realm of city law enforcement.

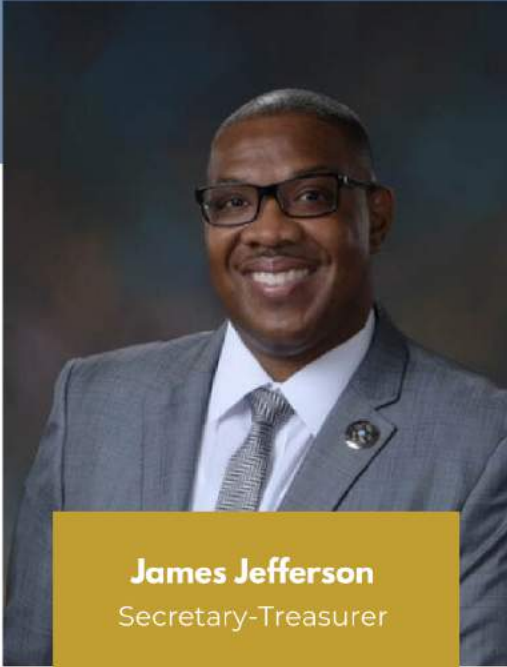

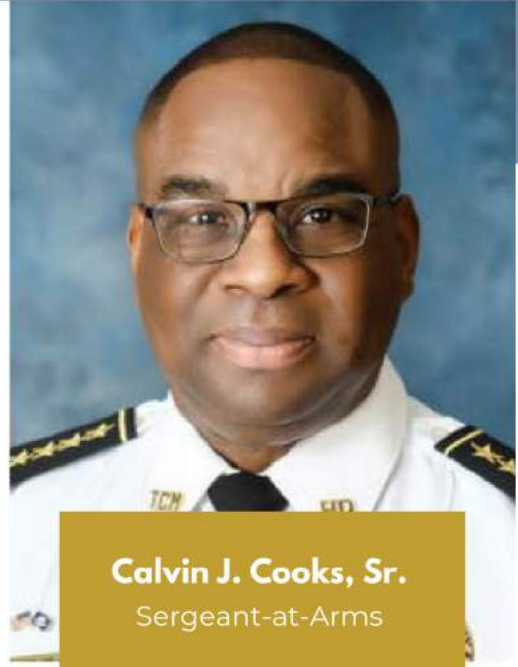

# PRESENTERS BIOGRAPHY



**Sergeant Ryan Richard**, a US Marine Corps Veteran from South Louisiana, began his law enforcement career in 2004 with the Lafayette Police Department. He served in various roles, including patrol officer and narcotics team member, before transitioning to the training section in 2009. As a training coordinator until 2019, he acquired multiple instructor certifications and demonstrated a commitment to enhancing departmental capabilities. In 2019, he joined the Criminal Detectives Division and was promoted to Sergeant in 2021, overseeing patrol operations until January 2023. Presently, he commands the Special Response Group (Mobile Field Force) and serves as the Range Master/Supervisor, ensuring top-notch training standards at the Lafayette PD's Firing Range. Throughout his distinguished career, Sergeant Richard's exceptional performance has been recognized with 14 letters of commendation, two Detective of the Month awards, and a first-place victory in a sniper competition at an LTPOA Conference.



**Corporal David Mouton**, a United States Coast Guard Veteran born in Abbeville, began his law enforcement career in 2000 with the Vermilion Parish Sheriff's Office. Over the years, he served in various roles including Patrol Sergeant, Detective, and Commander of the Special Response Team. Mouton has extensive training in firearms instruction and SWAT operations. Joining the Lafayette Police Department in 2009, he has since become a vital member of the Executive Protection Unit, Swift Water Rescue Team, and Special Response Group (Mobile Field Force). Mouton is a dedicated volunteer with the Southern Law Enforcement Foundation and currently serves as the Co-Coordinator for Region 2. He continues to enhance his expertise in firearms through specialized training and currently holds the position of Range Master at the Lafayette PD's Firing Range, while also serving as a Team Leader in the Special Response Group.



**Deputy Kevin Reeves** serves as a supervisor for the Ward 3 Marshal's Office in Lake Charles and currently oversees the daily operations of the Marshals Office. Deputy Reeves is responsible for purchasing and maintaining all equipment as well as the fleet. He also coordinates all parades for the City of Lake Charles, Special Events, Off-Duty Security, Reserve Division, and everything in between. Deputy Reeves previously worked for the Calcasieu Parish Sheriffs Office and has over 27 years of experience.



**George P. Belsky, Jr.**, a certified Blue Courage instructor, brings a wealth of expertise from his extensive military and law enforcement career spanning over three decades. Graduating from the US Military Academy at West Point in 1984, George served in various leadership roles during his five-year tenure in the US Army, including as a rifle platoon leader, anti-tank platoon leader, company executive officer, assistant operations/air officer, and staff officer at the US Army Infantry School. Following his distinguished military service, George continued his commitment to public service by transitioning to law enforcement, where he dedicated over twenty years to the US Postal Inspection Service and the US Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms & Explosives (ATF).
